III. DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE GENERAL ELECTION HELD NOVEMBER 6, 2018

1. Consider Adoption of Resolution No. BOE 03-18 - Declaring the Results of the 2018 General Election

City Attorney Avallone read Resolution No. BOE 03-18, declaring the results of the general election held November 6, 2018, by title only.

The unofficial results of the general election for the Mayor were:

- 8,916 votes were cast for Russ Owen
- 5,328 votes were cast for Lisa Martin

Based upon the unofficial records, Russ Owen was declared the winner.

The unofficial results of the general election for the Zone 1 Commissioner were:

- 6,509 votes were cast for Michael Kolody
- 6,422 votes were cast for Peggy Belflower.

Based upon the unofficial records, Michael Kolody was declared the winner.

Motion:

Vice Chair McGuirk moved to adopt Resolution No. BOE 03-18, declaring Russ Owen the winner of the Mayoral race and declaring Michael Kolody the winner of the Zone 1 Commissioner race. Member Sachs seconded the motion and the motion carried unanimously.
